1. Foreword

Article 18, para. 18.1 of the P-GAS Regulations provides that:

- to acquire the status of selling Participant, the Participant shall - under the modalities and within the time limits defined in the Technical Rules - submit the terms and conditions of supply of natural gas to GME;
- A Participant who also holds the exploitation lease, whether he/she has acquired or not acquired the status of selling Participant, shall - under the modalities and within the time limits indicated in the Technical Rules - provide GME with the terms and conditions of supply applicable to offers of royalties on the product of exploitation of gas fields owed to the State.

Article 18, para. 18.5 of the P-GAS Regulations stipulates that, if the selling Participant intends to change the terms and conditions of supply with respect to those previously sent to and published by GME, he/she shall notify GME thereof by sending the new terms and conditions of supply to GME, under the procedures and within the time limits indicated in the Technical Rules.

2. Procedure and time limits to notify GME of the terms and conditions of supply

The terms and conditions of supply, duly signed by the legal representative of the Participant or by other duly authorised person, shall be sent to GME by ordinary mail or courier.

GME shall publish the terms and conditions of supply on its website within five working days from receipt thereof and, within the same time limit, shall prepare the order book or the auction of the selling Participant.

3. Procedures and time limits to change the terms and conditions of supply

If the selling Participant intends to change the terms and conditions of supply with respect to those previously sent to and published by GME, he/she shall send to GME - by ordinary mail or courier - the new terms and conditions of supply, duly signed by his/her legal representative or other duly authorised person.

GME will publish all the received documents on its website within five days from receipt thereof.
