1. Foreword

Article 2, para 2.1 l), of the Market Rules for certificates of release to consumption of biofuels defines working day as the day from Monday to Friday, except for the days that the State recognises as public holidays for all civil effects, as well as those possibly indicated in the Technical Rules.

2. Holidays

The following days shall be regarded as holidays:

1) NATIONAL HOLIDAY, under Law no. 336 of 20 November 2000:

- 2 June (Republic's Day)

2) OTHER HOLIDAYS, under Law no. 260 of 27 May 1949:

- 25 April (Liberation Day)
- Easter Monday
- 1 May (Labour Day)
- 26 December (St. Stephen's Day)

3) RELIGIOUS HOLIDAYS RECOGNIZED AS HOLIDAYS FOR ALL CIVIL PURPOSES under Decree of the President of the Republic no.792 of 28 December 1985:

- 1 January (New Year's Day Solemnity of Mary)
- 6 January (Epiphany)
- 29 June (Saints Peter and Paul Day)
- 15 August (Assumption Day)
- 1 November (All Saint's Day)
- 8 December (Immaculate Conception)
- 25 December (Christmas)
