1. Introduction

Article 2, paragraph 2.1, letter m), of the Regulations defines as working day each day from Monday to Friday, with the exception of those recognised as public holidays by the State for all civil purposes, as well as those possibly indicated in the Technical Rules.

2. Public holidays

In particular, the following days shall be considered as public holidays:

- 1) NATIONAL HOLIDAY, pursuant to Law no. 336 of 20 November 2000:
 - 2 June (Republic Day)
- 2) PUBLIC HOLIDAYS, pursuant to Law no. 260 of 27 May 1949:
 - April 25 (Liberation Day)
 - Easter Monday
 - 1 May (Labour Day)
 - 26 December (St. Stephen's Day)
- 3) RELIGIOUS HOLIDAYS RECOGNISED AS PUBLIC HOLIDAYS FOR CIVIL PURPOSES, pursuant to Italian Presidential Decree no. 792 of 28 December 1985:
 - 1 January (New Year's Day)
 - January 6 (Epiphany)
 - 29 June (Saints Peter and Paul)
 - 15 August (Assumption Day)
 - 1 November (all Saints Day)
 - 8 December (Immaculate Conception)
 - 25 December (Christmas Day)
