## 1. Foreword

Article 35 of the Regulations provides that, under the emergency conditions specified therein, GME's communications shall take place as described in the Technical Rules.

## 2. Emergency communications between GME and PB-GAS Participants

As specified in Article 35, para. 35.2 of the Regulations, if GME is unable to receive bids/offers submitted by Participants owing to telecommunications failures, it will postpone the time of closing of the PB-GAS sitting, notifying Participants and Snam Rete Gas thereof through at least one of the following communication channels:

- GME's website;
- PB-GAS electronic platform;
- e-mail;
- fax.

If the failures persist, GME will suspend the sitting, notifying Participants and Snam Rete Gas thereof through at least one of the following communication channels:

- GME's website;
- PB-GAS electronic platform;
- e-mail;
- fax.

As set out in Article 35, para. 35.3 of the Regulations, if GME is unable to determine the results of a given session of the PB-GAS or to notify Participants of the results of a given session of the PB-GAS, it will suspend transactions on the PB-GAS, notifying Participants and Snam Rete Gas thereof through at least one of the following communication channels:

- GME's website;
- PB-GAS electronic platform;
- e-mail;
- fax.
