

Technical Rule no. 11 rev1 PB-GAS

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(pursuant to Article 4 of the Rules of the Platform for gas balancing, approved by the Authority for electricity, gas and water system with Resolution ARG/gas 145/11 of 28 October 2011 and subsequent amendments and integrations)

Title	Unit of measurement

Entry into force on 30 September 2015



1. Premise

Article 5, paragraph 5.1 of the Rules provides that, for purposes of the PB-GAS, GME shall adopt the units of measurement listed in the Technical Rules.

2. Unit of measurement

For the purpose of PB-GAS:

- the unit of measurement of the amount of gas is MWh/day, specified with three decimals;
- the unit of measurement of the currency is EUR, specified with two decimals;
- the unit of measurement of the unit prices of the gas is EUR/MWh, specified with three decimals.

3. Transitional arrangements for the sector G+1

With reference to the sector G+1 of the PB-GAS, the provisions of paragraph 2 of this DTF are used after the end of the session related to the day September 30, 2015. Therefore, only on the gas day September 30, 2015, for the purpose of the sector G+1 of the PB-GAS, they will be applied the following units of measurement:

- the unit of measurement of the amount of gas is the GJ/day, specified with a decimal;
- the unit of measurement of currency is EUR, specified with two decimals;
- the unit of measurement of the unit prices of the gas is EUR/GJ, specified with two decimals.
