1. Foreword

Art. 2.1 t) of the Integrated Text of the Electricity Market Rules defines working days as the days from Monday to Friday, except for the days that the State recognises as holidays for all civil purposes, as well as those possibly specified in the Technical Rules.

2. Holidays

The following days shall be regarded as holidays:

- 1) NATIONAL HOLIDAY, under Law no. 336 of 20 November 2000:
 - 2 June (Republic's Day)
- 2) OTHER HOLIDAYS, under Law no. 260 of 27 May 1949:
 - 25 April (Liberation Day)
 - Easter Monday
 - 1 May (Labour Day)
 - 26 December (St. Stephen's Day)
- 3) RELIGIOUS HOLIDAYS RECOGNISED AS HOLIDAYS FOR CIVIL PURPOSES, under Decree of the President of the Republic no. 792 of 28 December 1985:
 - 1 January (New Year's Day Solemnity of Mary)
 - 6 January (Epiphany)
 - 29 June (Saints Peter and Paul Day)
 - 15 August (Assumption Day)
 - 1 November (All Saints' Day)
 - 8 December (Immaculate Conception)
 - 25 December (Christmas)
- 4) 29 June (Saints Peter and Paul Day) for purposes of invoicing and settlement of payments by GME.
- 5) HOLIDAY under Law-Decree no. 5 of 22 February 2011:
 - 17 March 2011 (150th Anniversary of the Unity of Italy).
