1. Foreword

Article 5, paragraph 5.1, letter a), of the Integrated Text of the Electricity Market Rules provides that, for the purposes of the market, the unit of measurement of electricity is the MWh, specifying the number of decimals indicated in the Technical Rules.

2. Unit of measurement

For the purposes of conducting the markets of which the ME is composed, the MWh is adopted as the unit of measurement of electricity with the following specification of decimals:

- on the MGP, MI-A, MSD, PN, MPEG and MTE, the number of decimals is equal to 3;
- on the MI-XBID, the number of decimals is equal to 1.
