Technical Rule no. 03 Rev. 01 PPA Bulletin Board

(pursuant to article 4 of the Regulation of Bulletin Board of long-term energy contracts from renewable sources)

1. Introduction

Article 5, paragraph 5.1, of the Regulation of Bulletin Board of long-term energy contracts from renewable sources provides that, for the purposes of the PPA Bulletin Board, GME shall adopt the units of measurement indicated in the Technical Rules.

2. Unit of measurement

For the purposes of the PPA Bulletin Board:

- a) the unit of measurement of quantity¹ of electricity subject to:
 - i) a notice on the Notice Section or of a contract on the Contract Registration Section is the MWh, with specification of two decimal places;
 - ii) offer on the *Energy Release* Section is MWh/year, without specification of decimal places;
 - iii) allocation on the *Energy Release* Section is the MWh/year, with specification of three decimal places².
- b) the unit of measurement of unit prices³ of a notice on the Notice Section or of a contract on the Contract Registration Section is the Euro/MWh, with specification of two decimal places;
- c) the unit of measurement of the sale offer price⁴ on the *Energy Release* Section is the Euro/MWh, with specification of two decimal places;

¹ Quantities specified in notices or in contract registrations and in the offers of the Energy Release section can only take positive values.

² Unlike the offers, the amounts allocated as consequence of the result determination are expressed with three decimals, given the use a pro-quota basis (see Technical Rule n. 05 PPA Bulletin Board).

³ Prices specified in notices or in contract registrations can only take positive values.

⁴ The sale offer price can only take positive values.

- d) the unit of measurement of the capacity of a power plant associated with the notice on the Notice Section or to the contract on the Contract Registration Section is the MW, with specification of two decimal places;
- e) the monetary unit of measurement is the Euro, with specification of two decimals.
