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1. Foreword

Article 43, para 43.2 of the Rules Governing the Forward Account Registration Platform (hereafter “PCE Rules”) provides that, for the purpose of conducting technical adequacy verifications, the requests for registering CET bids/offers shall be ranked by price priority and, if they have the same price priority in accordance with the criteria laid down in the Dispatching Rules. Under Article 43, para. 43.3 of the PCE Rules, if, by applying the above-mentioned criteria, the submitted CET bids/offers have the same priority, then their priority order shall be determined in accordance with the modalities set out in the Technical Rules.

2. Priority order

If, after applying the priority criteria referred to in Article 43, para 43.2 of the PCE Rules, the submitted CET bids/offers have the same priority, they will be ranked in order of time of receipt of the requests for registration of CET bids/offers by the PCE information system.

If a request for registration has been submitted via an XML file and such request specifies multiple CET bids/offers and if, by applying the criteria referred to in Article 43, para 43.2 of the PCE Rules, such bids/offers have the same priority, then they will be ranked in the order in which they have been specified in the same file.
