1. Foreword

Article 26, paragraph 26.7 of the Integrated Text of the Electricity Market Rules (hereafter “ME Rules”) provides that, in the MGP, MI, and MSD, the unit prices specified in demand bids and supply offers must be included within the technical limits indicated in the Technical Rules in compliance with the relevant European legislation.

2. Technical limits of bids/offers in the MGP

In compliance with “ACER Decision no. 01-2023 on the NOMINATED ELECTRICITY MARKET OPERATORS PROPOSAL FOR THE HARMONISED MAXIMUM AND MINIMUM CLEARING PRICE METHODOLOGY FOR THE SINGLE DAY-AHEAD COUPLING”, the minimum and maximum technical limits of bids/offers in the MGP will be equal to:

- - 500 €/MWh, and
- +4,000 €/MWh, respectively.

3. Technical limits of bids/offers in the MI

In compliance with “ACER Decision no. 02-2023 on the NOMINATED ELECTRICITY MARKET OPERATORS PROPOSAL FOR THE HARMONISED MAXIMUM AND MINIMUM CLEARING PRICE METHODOLOGY FOR THE SINGLE INTRADAY COUPLING”, the minimum and maximum technical limits of bids/offers in the MI (both MI-A and MI-XBID) will be equal to:

- - 9,999 €/MWh, and
- +9,999 €/MWh, respectively.

4. Technical limits of bids/offers in the MSD

The limits of bids/offers in the MSD will be those referred to in the Dispatching Rules.
